Guidelines for Peer Reviewers

The editors of *Buildings & Landscapes* are grateful to you for taking the time to review the attached manuscript. We would very much like to receive the report within six weeks. If that's not possible, please let us know when we may expect the report and/or suggest another reader.

In your evaluation, please make a clear-cut recommendation:

- Accept (specify minor revisions if necessary)
- Revise and resubmit (specify conditions)
- Reject (specify reasons)

We are interested in a comprehensive review of *at least* one page in length (single-spaced, longer reports are welcome). Our authors usually find it helpful to receive a report that is divided into two parts, with the first section discussing argument, use of evidence, organization, and other overarching concerns; and the second offering specific editorial comments, usually page by page. You are not obliged to follow this format but please do if so inclined. In any event, please comment on:

- Originality of concept
- Methodology and sources
- Argument and use of evidence, including illustrations
- Illustration program
- Elegance of style and clarity of organization
- Contribution to vernacular architecture and cultural landscape studies

The editors are committed to making *Buildings & Landscapes* a source of rigorous scholarship. The double blind peer review process and your expertise are vital to making this goal a reality. Your report will be forwarded anonymously to the author, unless you indicate otherwise. Regardless, we encourage reviewers to be critical, offer suggestions for improvement, and at the same time to be collegial and courteous in tone.
